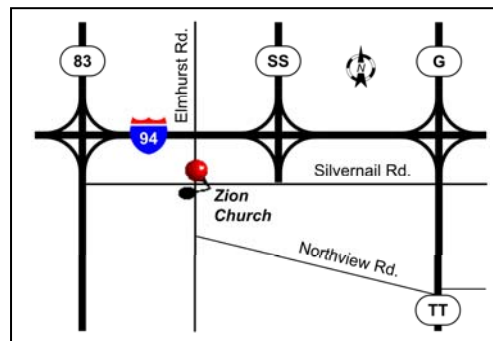

Our Church

Zion Presbyterian Church was first organized in 1866 and rebuilt in 1965 to better serve the growing community. Our worship is inspired by an exceptional choir, wonderful organ music and beautiful stained glass windows.

Life and Ministry

We have Sunday School, adult Bible study, spiritual exploration groups and a book club. We schedule a variety of fun activities throughout the year to promote Christian fellowship and to raise funds to support the needs of our local and global community. Our members are active in ecumenical projects such as the Inter-church Lay Council of Pewaukee, the Waukesha and Pewaukee food pantries, Interfaith, and the Cooperating Congregations of Waukesha County (CCWC).

What We Believe

We are seekers of truth, in an on-going dialogue with scripture, with each other, and with what is going on in the world around us. We represent many different theological positions, but we work out of the Reformed Tradition, begun by John Calvin in 16th century Geneva, Switzerland. To handle the Word of God responsibly, Presbyterians have always stressed the importance of learning.

We believe that Jesus Christ is the head of the church, and that no single person should have authority over others in ruling the church. Therefore, our form of government is by Elders elected from the congregation and our ministers, working together.
